So keep that thought and remember that no matter how bad a day may be, there are people here that are proud of you.







Join The Parliament!

Consider serving TRMN as a Member of Parliament. Watch for announcements of the next elections. There are approximately 15 seats available for Gryphon Fleet members.

Eligibility requirements to serve as a Member of Parliament - you must not be serving in a "Hatted" role within the organization as well as the following

- Been a member for at least one year
- Completed, at least, your first exam through BuTrain
- Have attended at least one event. An event defined as a Chapter Meeting, Convention, Chapter or Fleet Event (movie night, charity drive). The event can be virtual.
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have not had any warning or censure in the previous 12 months



In addition, if you are a Peer, a Chapter Commander or member of the Command Triad, a Fleet/Station Commander, a Space Lord, or a member of the Royal Council you are prohibited from serving in the House of Commons. Additionally, if you serve on the staffs of one of these positions, you are prohibited from serving in the House of Commons.
