Flag Sends

Dear fellow members of mighty Gryphon Fleet,

Online and in person, we employ many ranks, titles, abbreviations, and jargon from the Honorverse series. This language is part of our group culture and the Honorverse role-play "flavor" is part of the fun of participating in The Royal Manticoran Navy.

There is a usage which many of us commonly get wrong, and it is simple to get right once you are aware of it. When saying or writing a ship's name, never put "the" before HMS! There are both historical and canon reasons for this. First of all, if you remember that "HMS" stands for "Her Majesty's Ship," then you will realize that it makes no sense to say "the Her Majesty's Ship." And indeed, if you look at the U.K.'s Royal Navy official usage in the real world, you will see that they never use "the" in this context, and never have.

Indeed, even the US Navy Style Guide https://www.navy.mil/submit/navyStyleGuide.pdf page 12 states: "Do not use "the" in front of a ship's name: "USS San Jose," not "the USS San Jose."

And that is official, even though "the United States Ship (NAME)" does not sound so jarring as "the Her Majesty's Ship (NAME)."

Additionally, and more importantly, in the

DCO's Note

Theodore Roosevelt once talked about having the 'bully pulpit', and the advantages it brings. Of course, in his time, bully meant 'superb' or 'wonderful', and the phrase meant a terrific platform from which to advocate an agenda.

Writing the Fleet Newsletter is like that, especially when I give myself a column! My own version of Stan's Soapbox, for those of a certain age.

So I want to take a moment to talk about something I see a lot of posts about, not just from our TRMN family, but from others in the broader family of what I'll term active fandom - fandom that does things, not just consumes media (that would be inactive fandom).

That something would be depression.

It's a monster. Major depression, according to the National Institute of Mental Health, impacts no less then 6.7% of adults and 12.8% of adolescents. This does not include other causes, including postpartum, seasonal affective disorder, or persistent depressive disorder. There aren't any solid numbers on those - in part because depression impacts one's willingness to respond to surveys about depression.

This is part of why I have begun referring to depression as if it was alive - it keeps acting like it is. If you remember back to high school science (or earlier), some wit undoubtedly mentioned that fire was alive. After all, it breathes, consumes, excretes, and dies without food or oxygen. Well, same with depression. It conceals itself, it feeds, it excretes, and it can be starved.

And too many good people in fandom suffer from this illness. Far too many.

I am not a doctor, not a therapist. I can't say 'do this, don't do that' from a place of any training or authority. What I can do is speak as one of those people who has dealt with

depression for most of my life. I can speak as one who knows from the inside how it can feel, how it can affect...well...everything. And I can also say that I know that no two illnesses are alike.

What they do all share is a desire on the part of the illness to destroy you. Like an overly aggressive parasite, the depression feeds on you, and drives you toward an early end. One way or another. It isn't all suicide - depression in my case leads to poor / overeating, not taking physical care of myself, and other actions that lead to physical diseases like heart disease, diabetes, liver or kidney failure, and others.

Your results may vary.

What helps? From what I can tell (my experience and reading posts of others), the most help is in listening, being there when we are able or ready to engage, being supportive, and accepting that this isn't something that is going to resolve itself quickly, easily, or without pain. Sometimes it means being strong for someone when you really need someone to be strong for you instead.

It's hard. And it isn't always successful, you aren't fighting a static thing, but a foe who will fight back, from a position of strength no less.

So, can we all agree to help when we can? Do what we can? Even if it's just to be a PM away, or keep asking people to events? Knowing that people want you around can be a great boost when the pit is opening beneath you.

Above all else though, listen. Even if the thing taxing your friends makes no sense to you. Especially if...

Listen. Be there. Be kind. Help each other. We can beat this. Please remember that.

HMS Hotspur Fundraiser Report

On August 10th, HMS Hotspur hosted a fundraiser for the Rantoul Public Library, where they have their monthly meetings and Artemis events.

The Rantoul library is one of the buildings that used to be part of Chanute Air Force Base, which was decommissioned in 1993. Since then, the roof has become in dire need of repair, as it leaks in many places, and this has damaged some of the collection, and is placing the remainder (including base archives and records) in jeopardy.

To get the fundraising ball rolling, HMS Hotspur planned, organized, and executed a pair of fundraising events - an Euchre Tournament and a silent auction. The auction concluded during the tournament, which also featured a raffle.

Taking the reins in the planning and organizing were Administrative Specialists Diana Flanagan and Violet Lapine. They did the bulk of the organizing and planning for both the auction and tournament. Executive Officer LTSG Debbie Fligor was instrumental in securing many of the games used as auction items. Other members contributing to the setup, operation (including a recruiting table), refreshments and tear-down were Hotspur's CO LTCDR Michael Flanagan, Bosun Senior Chief Intelligence Mate Kevin Walsh, PO3/c Daniel Lapine, and Sr. Cadet Ranger Kylie Fugate.

The end result? HMS Hotspur was able to deliver over \$1300.00 toward the roofing project.

MARDET Changes

The Marshall of the Corps released the new MARDET structures on Sunday, the 26th of August. In the Facebook channel, he also indicated that "Existing MARDETs will be upgraded to the largest size that their parent hull can support. Brevets, if necessary, will be done on a case by case basis in accordance with established AOs." The full AO PDF is reproduced on the following two pages,

So, based on that directive, the following MARDETS will be sized as follows:

MARDET Ajax to Battalion
MARDET Demon to Company + Platoon
MARDET Invincible remains a Battalion
MARDET Musashi to Battalion
MARDET Peregrine to Platoon
MARDET Valkyrie to Battalion

For our Super Dreadnoughts, this may not be a change. For our smaller MARDETS, this will be a big change. As ever, please feel free to contact your echelon or RMMC leadership with any questions or issues.

Honorverse oeuvre, covering thousands of pages, the word string "the HMS" appears only once, and that is in a short story by one of David Weber's co-authors, where it appears to have been an oversight. David himself never uses "the HMS."

So, the tip of the month for sounding like an authentic spacer: say (or write) "HMS Fearless" instead of "the HMS Fearless." It's fine to use, for example, "the heavy cruiser HMS Fearless," but avoid putting "the HMS" together.

It's not a big deal, but it is a simple way to enhance our Honorverse style. And remember, it can be difficult not to come off as an obnoxious pedant when correcting others on these language minutiae - I hope that I have not! So, if you correct your fellow members, be gentle about it and do it with a positive spirit of mutual improvement!

Re: RMMC Echelon Breakdown (Corps Directive 03-1808)

As of the date of this Order, by my hand, and by the authority of the Sovereign, Queen of Manticore Elizabeth III, I hereby institute the Echelon Breakdown. Please note that this order supersedes Corps Directive 01-1709.

RMMC Echelon Breakdown

Below is a chart which illustrates the breakdown, by echelon, of the Royal Manticoran Marine Corps. The first column of the chart lists the echelons of the RMMC from the smallest to largest unit. The second column illustrates the breakdown per echelon for role-playing. That is these numbers should be used for stories and detail out the RMMC if the RMMC of the Honorverse actually existed. The third column illustrates the breakdown per echelon for the fan club The Royal Manticoran Navy: The Official Honor Harrington Fan Association, Inc. These are the numbers that the fan organization and consequently the RMMC will use to divide the organization by.

The numbers below are a generalization and simplification of what an actual breakdown of the echelons would be. For instance, not listed are the various staff members that would be attached to the various units. Those have not been because they would needlessly complicate this chart. Units in the RMMC that are of Company size or larger may have staffs, but those are at the discretion of the commanding officer. All effort should be made to minimize the size of the staff and any staff should be proportional to the size of the unit.
