

reflect on how we approach the world.

My natural tendency is to see the negative. I fight it constantly, seeking to find something positive in even the darkest outcomes.

SMCPON Position Open

The position of Senior Master Petty Officer of the Navy (SMCPON) RMN is now available.

Job description:

This description is subject to change by Naval Directive or Admiralty Order.

Duties not listed in the job description include:

- Reports to the First Space Lord and as part of the 1SL Staff, provide written reports as requested and attend regularly scheduled meetings.
- Organizing and chairing the bimonthly Senior Enlisted Promotion Review Board.
- Maintain various social media pages (i.e.Facebook, TRMN Forum) to disseminate information and answer questions.
- Supervise and maintain the Office of the SMCPON to include three E-7 and above staff members. Also, recruit additional advisors as needed.
- Act as an advisor and mentor to the Bosun cadre of the Royal Manticoran Navy for purposes of training, communication and overall guidance for morale and policy. Provide same/similar guidance, upon request, to Top Senior Enlisted position in all of Manticoran and Allied forces.
- Create and maintain records of interactions, situations, investigations and resolutions of concerns and or complaints. Some limited anonymity is understood.
- Create files for record keeping that are shareable, i.e. Google Drive, so that there is a historical record of concern/complaint incidents. Some limited anonymity is understood.
- Willingness to learn and teach the basic elements of Military Drill and Ceremonies, including,but not limited to: Positions under command, use of salute, turns, formations and marching.
- Willingness to learn and teach the basic use of a Bosun's Pipe and appropriate calls.
- Sharing the "best practices" attitude concerning stated official directives.
- Perform any additional duties deemed appropriate as the senior enlisted position of the Royal Manticoran Navy.

Required Qualifications:

- Tested up to E-10
- Computer capable
- Readily accessible on-line or via portable communication device
- Excellent communications ability, both verbal and written
- Able to take initiative within given parameters
- Ability to maintain confidentiality
- Able to maintain military bearing and decorum in dealings with all segments of the fan organization.
