# **MARDET Changes**

There are some changes to new MARDET chapters that we want to summarize here. In Corps Directive 03-1903, there is a change to how units are sized.

New MARDETs will now be sized based on their host ship's hull size. So, a MARDET on the superdreadnought HMS Any Ship will be a Battalion, regardless of actual headcount.

This is the case no matter the number of Marines. So long as a command triad of CO, XO, and Gunny is present (and tested to the correct ranks), these three Marines can indeed be a battalion. We have always represented far more people that are actually IN a chapter, this just codifies that reality.

Existing MARDETs will be changed to the appropriate size when possible by COMFORCECOM. Any needed billet changes (squad leaders, etc.) will be the responsibility of the MARDET CO.



# **Gryphon Trophy 2019**

GRYPHON FLEET ORDER 1901-C, 09JAN2019

2019 Gryphon Fleet challenges will be:

- Challenge period 1 (February 15th–May 15th): RANGE CHALLENGE (Gaming). Chapter that has the highest number of hours spent playing games during the challenge period wins.
- Challenge period 2 (May 30th–August 30th): ASTRO CONTROL CHALLENGE (Wings
  Qualifications). Chapter that has the highest number of their total official crew roster earn a
  set of Wings by the end of the challenge period wins.
- Challenge period 3 (September 15th–December 15th): GUNNERY CHALLENGE (Reading).
   Chapter that submits the most pages read during the challenge period at the end of the challenge period wins.

All ships' commanding officers, you or your delegated crew member will be responsible to report your ship's performance to the Fleet Intelligence Officer: intel@2ndfleet.trmn.org.

All challenges will be conducted according to Black Sphinx Cup rules. After all three challenges have been completed, the overall winning ship will be determined according to Black Sphinx Cup rules.

The winning ship will be presented with the traveling GRYPHON TROPHY to display during 2020, and the ship's crew members will be awarded the FLEET EXCELLENCE AWARD with gold "E" and be considered against the winners from other fleets for the navy's overall Black Sphinx Cup.

Good luck to all ships! I hope to see wide participation that demonstrates the excellence of Gryphon Fleet!

# **Stand For Parliament!**


Greetings, members of the 2nd Fleet Area of Responsibility!

The House of Commons just passed a set of <u>Interim Rules</u>, one of which requires at least one qualified TRMN member to state their intention to stand for election before the House of Commons will call for a by-election in a particular AOR. The 2nd Fleet AOR does not have its full complement of MPs and won't have a general election until April 2020, so if this AOR wishes to have the opportunity to fill some or all of the empty seats, at least one of you will have to indicate that you are interested in running. You can do so by stating this in a post below.


