DCO's Note

John Neitz is why I am in TRMN. I know that in this Fleet, that may not seem unusual - many of us can say that, either directly or because he recruited the person who recruited us.

In my case, it was direct, but not in person. I had joined the TRMN Facebook page and John chimed in to ask if I had joined the organization itself yet. I did a few days later. joining HMS Galahad, the sole Chicago ship at that time.

About that time, there was a push to get crests updated, and I chimed in that I could indeed do that, if HMS Galahad needed it. And suddenly I was 'active', and that activity led to the creation of HMS Tornado, to serve the south half of Chicagoland, in November, 2014, and my promotion to XO. A few months later, the original CO moved on, and I was promoted to CO, and then Tornado became HMS Odin, and with that came another promotion.

Then, in 2016, due to bad weather, I was the only one to make a gaming session at Admiralty House (then in Libertyville, IL), and the FLA asked if I could make it to MarsCon (MN) in a week or so. I could, and that one event started me down the path I am on now.

At MarsCon, we lined the halls for then-CAPTSG Bill Lochen's retirement as CO, HMS Invincible. I saw the number of different ships represented, and the number of representatives of those ships, and realized that in Chicago, it would be 1 from HMS Odin, 3 from HMS Gallant, and that was it. We couldn't muster 5 people in the region, much less off one ship. And that was the seed that became HMS Demon - a large chapter for everyone, so we could be a group on one ship, and a carrier so that we could better explain what we were (everyone gets 'carrier'...not many get 'light cruiser').

HMS Demon's creation put me back as XO, and when then-CAPTSG Sherman Day was elevated to CO, TF22, I moved to CO, then added CO TG22.1 as a second hat.

When Justin Grays formally resigned as DCO of Second Fleet last year, I tossed my beret in the ring. I honestly expected it to go to a specific few people in the MSP area, and so I was surprised to be accepted, and have spent the last year as DCO, learning from VADM Neitz, and simultaneously looking forward to and dreading this moment.

And here we are. But for better weather, I might not have known about (much less attended) MarsCon, and not seen so many of us in one place.

My path in TRMN has been one of trying to be where I am most needed at any given point - from serving as XO and then CO on HMS Tornado to stepping up to serve as DCO for the fleet.

My goal as the new CO for Second Fleet is to serve you, our members. Your ship COs, echelon COs and their XOs, Bosuns, and other leaders are among the best in not only the Royal Manticoran Navy, but in fandom in general. Trust them. I do.

I know it is weird to think of someone else's name as CO. VADM Neitz has been our fleet CO for seven years. He is himself an institution in this organization, and that will always be recognized. It is weird to me too.



Gryphon Fleet Newsletter

Buships Directive 1903-13: Streamlined Command Review Process, Local Level Participation.

Beginning 1 April 2019, requirements for determining Command Fitness necessitating two (2) endorsements to be supplied on behalf of any member wishing to take on the duty of a Command Triad position (CO, XO, or Ship's Bosun) as laid out in Bureau of Ships Directive 1806-01 (Adjustment of Criteria for Command Fitness) are rescinded.

Moving forward, any member wishing to take on the duty of a ship's Commanding Officer must have at least one (1) written endorsement/letter of recommendation from a member within their prospective chain of command. The list of eligible endorsing officers shall be limited to the following:

- Sitting Member of the Royal Council
- Space Lords and Deputy Space Lords
- Commanding Officer of the affected
 Numbered Fleet
- Deputy Commanding Officer of the affected
 Numbered Fleet
- Chief of Staff of the affected Numbered
 Fleet
- Affected Task Force Commanding Officer
- Affected Task Group Commanding Officer
- Affected Squadron Commanding Officer
- Affected Division Commanding Officer
- Chapter Commanding Officers in Proximity to the Affected or Prospective Chapter

IN LIEU OF AN ENDORSEMENT/LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION, the prospective CO may receive counseling from a member of the affected Task Group, Task Force, or Fleet command staff on the duties and requirements of a ship's commanding officer. After said counseling, the Division, Squadron, Task Group, Task Force, OR Fleet Command Staff Member (Fleet Commander, Deputy Fleet Commander, Fleet Chief of Staff) will submit a Statement of Counseling to BuShips, attesting that he/she feels the prospective CO understands the duties involved with the position of ship's Commanding Officer and feels that the prospective CO is up to the task.

Endorsements/Letters of Recommendation and/or Statements of Counseling must be addressed to the Office of the Third Space Lord (buships@trmn.org). Example Endorsements/Letters of Recommendation and Statements of Counseling will be available upon request to act as a guide.

The intention of this new process is to involve the Fleets and Echelons in their own growth by including them in the conversation with respect to approvals. This was the original process in the early stages of our organization's development, and we feel that a formal approach to this notion will help us understand how best to serve the Fleets and Echelons by encouraging engagement at those levels.




