# Flag Sends

This newsletter almost didn't happen.

As we have spent the last month (or more) in a holding pattern of isolation, I have had a lot of motivation issues. Specifically, not having any. It sucks. And I was all prepared to send out an email apologizing for the lack of newsletter, and chalking it up as another COVID-19 casualty.

But that isn't something I find acceptable.

It may be old-fashioned, but at my core, I believe that 'I don't feel like it' is not an acceptable excuse. When I accepted this role, it wasn't to be FCO when I felt like it, or when it was easy, but to do this when it wasn't easy, when I didn't feel up to it. So here we are.

Herd immunity is the condition achieved when a sufficient percentage of the population is immune to a disease (naturally or via vaccination) that one sick person isn't able to spread the disease in a meaningful manner. Thus, those not immune are protected by the prevalence of immune peoples.



# **Wound Stripe Award Criteria Variance**

AWARD VARIANCE ANNOUNCEMENT 1703-20

Office of the Judge Advocate General, as part of the Office of the First Lord of the Admiralty

The purpose of the Wound Stripe is to encourage the donation of blood at Admiralty House and Fleet events, as donated blood is almost always needed by medical organizations. In the current pandemic blood is especially needed, and the opportunities to donate officially are shrinking due to cancellations.

The First Lord of the Admiralty has therefore agreed to the following temporary variance to the requirements for the Wound Stripe:

All blood donations between 0000 hours 18 March 2020 (EST) and 1159 hours 31 May 2020 (EST) shall count as a donation at an Admiralty House or Fleet event for the purposes of the Wound Stripe.

This variance means that any TRMN member who has NOT been awarded the Wound Stripe previously and donates during the timeframe listed above will be eligible for being awarded the Wound Stripe. Any member who HAS been previously awarded the Wound Stripe may count this as one (1) of the three (3) required donations at Admiralty House or Fleet events in order to receive subsequent

awards of the Wound Stripe.

Documentation must be submitted in order to receive the Wound Stripe showing the date and location of the donation (please redact any Personally Identifiable Information). Each Fleet is requested to collect the information and submit it to the BuPers award department in batches rather than members submitting directly.

If pandemic circumstances and convention cancellations are still ongoing as of 31 May 2020, the FLA retains the authority to review or extend this variance.


## **Blood Drive Form**

Per the above, we have a tracking form for donations.

Donations not logged will not be eligible for award under this variance, thanks!

Acceptable proof is required – a selfie as you donate, a certificate from the recipient agency, something to show the donation happened.



## Flag Sends continued

How does that work in the real world? Well, that takes some science.

Communicability of diseases is expressed as  $R_0$ , the basic reproduction number. This is used to express the expected number of cases directly generated by one case in a population where all individuals are susceptible to infection (like COVID-19). Seasonal flu has an  $R_0$  of between 0.9–2.1. COVID-19 is estimated at 1.4–5.7. This means that one person will infect 1–2 people with the flu, but 1–5 people with COVID-19. By way of comparison, 1 person with measles will infect (an a non–immune population) 12–18 people.

So, the higher the  $R_0$  number, the more virulent the disease.

The herd immunity threshold (HIT) scales to the  $R_0$  number. The higher  $R_0$ , the more immune people you need to attain herd immunity. So, to attain the herd immunity threshold, you need 92% – 95% immunity for measles. For the flu, maybe 25%.

For COVID-19, the estimates range between 27% and 74%. This is one of the hard parts about novel viruses – the unknowns are pretty unknown. So, what that means is you need, for sake of argument let's average these, 50% of the population immune. And there can't be a vaccine until, at the earliest, April of 2021. Which means we can only achieve herd immunity if some 165,501,325 people get sick.

Illinois has a case death rate over 5%. At that rate, that's 8,275,066 fatalities. Obviously, that is a wild estimate based on my state's experience (yours will vary), an average to get the HIT, and nothing weird happening. Kind of horrorshow, isn't it?

That even assumes that antibodies generated by having had the disease confer immunity (which is, actually, a safe assumption based on other corona—type viruses).

I would not rely on herd immunity to protect me, personally.

Your community will vary – we have seen how the disease is expressing differently in different places. There is no one right answer. I am not trying to tell you how to respond, merely providing some information on a topic that is

getting a lot of discussion recently.

In related news, Monday, April 27th, a judge in Coal County, IL, ruled that the governor had exceeded his authority in extending the state stay—at—home order until the end of May, and issued a stay. What does that mean? Basically, the Illinois constitution is explicitly clear about declared states of emergency — you get 30 days. I expect the General Assembly will act to extend that power in this case, but for now, that has not happened.

That is a lot of explanation for this next bit. When your state does reopen, I ask that if you have been working in the public during the shut—down, that you consider taking some time before jumping right back into things. My wife, for example, works in a hospital lab, and will be doing COVID—19 tests (not as her main thing, but will be doing it). I won't be getting together with folk for a bit as a safety measure. Obviously, I cannot order that. But I can ask that you consider your possible exposure, and risk, and think about others before joining in group activities.

We are going to get through this – it's only been a month, and will, hopefully, only be another month or two. Three months is totally survivable – our ancestors survived so much worse with so much less.

Please keep in touch with each other, your chapter and echelon leaders, and your non-TRMN friends and family. The lack of personal contact is hard on us all, and we owe it to ourselves and each other to mitigate that as much as we are able.

I'll see you once this is over!
